Soil stabilization shall be applied within seven (7) days from being last disturbed. Sediment barriers, settling ponds, or other control structures shall be used as recommended by the Holmes SWCD.

I hereby certify that I understand the provisions of the Holmes County Subdivision Regulations Sections 9.04 and 9.05 and that I accept responsibility for containing sediment and erosion on the construction site during construction activities. I further grant the right-of-entry onto the project site of the designated personnel of the Holmes SWCD for the purpose of inspecting for compliance with the Holmes County Subdivision Regulations Sections 9.04 and 9.05. Neither the District nor its representatives, nor the landowner will be liable for any damage to the other's property in carrying out the provisions of the agreement, unless such damage is caused by negligence or misconduct.
