THE MINUTES September 10, 2009

The Holmes County Commissioners met in regular session Thursday, September 10, 2009; with everyone present Chairman Miller opened the meeting:

JACKIE McKEE - AUDITOR - BUDGET DISCUSSION

Auditor Jackie McKee, Treasurer Joyce Yoder and Michele Gerber of the Auditor's office met with the Commissioners and discussed the estimated revenue for 2009.

McKee informed the Commissioners that the estimated revenue will be short \$195,915.77 for 2009. McKee would like to reduce the revenue by that amount for the first time since she has become Auditor. McKee presented the Commissioners with a proposal to reduce the estimated revenue.

Miller stated that we need to know this now, so we can make the proper adjustments to the budget.

McKee also informed the Commissioners that sales tax is just slightly behind what has been received in year's past.

We are protecting ourselves so that we have a positive carry-over, by reducing the estimated revenue stated McKee. It is also possible that there will not be a carry over for the 2010 budget.

Eyler does not want to see a deficit at the end of 2009.

McKee stated that we are working with estimates and there are too many unknowns.

Miller would like to see the departments make changes also. If no one turns in any money for a carry over, the budget will be worse in 2010.

Miller would like to know what the priorities are for the County? We are technology poor. Miller knows of County's that do not have the technology that we do and are in really good shape financially.

Yoder has cut her budget as much as possible. McKee has cancelled maintenance agreements and supplies.

Ault stated that the bottom line is that we have a certain amount of money and that is it.

McKee would like to see everyone work together.

The decision was made to have McKee will draft up a memo that will let the departments know that there is a short fall and see how much they can reduce now and return at the end of the year.

KEITH KIMBLE - KIMBLE LANDFILL - RECYCLING DISCUSSION

Keith Kimble of Kimble Companies and Scott Walter of J & J Refuse met with the Commissioners to discuss the recycling in Holmes County and the Holmes County Landfill. Walters looked at nine recycling sites throughout Holmes County to pick up the recycling for Holmes County. Total cost per month to pick up the recycling would be \$4,991.00. No decision was made at this time.

Kimble also gave an estimate to close the County Landfill. The cost to put a permanent cap on the Landfill would be \$1,400,000.00. Kimble will get back with the Commissioners with more information at a later date.
